3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Andrew Connolly Vet-
5 erans’ Housing Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY OF THE SECRETARY OF**
2 **VETERANS AFFAIRS TO PROVIDE SPECIALLY**
3 **ADAPTED HOUSING ASSISTANCE TO INDIVID-**
4 **UALS RESIDING TEMPORARILY IN HOUSING**
5 **OWNED BY A FAMILY MEMBER.**
