- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Marine Turtle Con-
- 5 servation Reauthorization Act of 2011".
- 6 SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO PROVISIONS PREVENTING FUND-
- 7 ING OF PROJECTS IN THE UNITED STATES.
- 8 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Marine Turtle Conservation
- 9 Act of 2004 is amended—

1 (1) in section 2(b) (16 U.S.C. 6601(b)), by 2 striking "in foreign countries"; (2) in section 3(2) (16 U.S.C. 6602(2))— 3 4 (A) in the matter preceding subparagraph 5 (A), by striking "in foreign countries"; and 6 (B) in subparagraph (D), by striking "of 7 foreign countries"; and 8 (3) in section 4 (16 U.S.C. 6603)— 9 (A) in subsection (b)(1)(A), by inserting "State or" before "foreign country"; and 10 11 (B) in subsection (d), by striking "in for-12 eign countries". 13 (b) STATE DEFINED.—Section 3 of such Act (16 14 U.S.C. 6602) is amended by adding at the end the fol-15 lowing new paragraph: "(7) STATE.—The term 'State' means each of 16 17 the several States of the United States, the District 18 of Columbia, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, Guam, 19 American Samoa, the Commonwealth of the North-20 ern Mariana Islands, any other territory or posses-21 sion of the United States, and any Indian tribe.". 22 SEC. 3. LIMITATIONS ON EXPENDITURES. 23 Section 5(b) of the Marine Turtle Conservation Act of 2004 (16 U.S.C. 6604(b)) is amended—
