3 **SECTION 1. FUNDING FOR NONDISCRIMINATION PROVI-**
4 **SIONS.**

5 The last sentence of section 140(b) of title 23, United
6 States Code, is amended—

7 (1) by striking “not to exceed”;

8 (2) by striking “may be” and inserting “shall
9 be”; and

1 (3) by striking “upon request of the State
2 transportation department to the Secretary”.
