A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “PATRIOT Sunsets
5 Extension Act of 2011”.

10 ligence Reform and Terrorism Prevention Act of 2004
11 (Public Law 108–458; 50 U.S.C. 1801 note) is amended
12 by striking “May 27, 2011” and inserting “June 1,
13 2015”.
