3 **SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY OF TERRITORIES FOR JOBS**
4 **CORPS CENTERS.**

1 (1) in paragraph (1)(A), by inserting “or simi-
2 lar agency of an outlying area,” after “local agen-
3 cy”; and

4 (2) in paragraph (2)(B)(i)(III), by inserting
5 “(or outlying area)” after “State”.
