3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “USPS Retiree Health
5 Benefits Prepayment Extension Act of 2011”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION.**

2 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 8909a(d)(3)(A)(v) of title
3 5, United States Code, is amended by striking “September
4 30, 2011” and inserting “December 31, 2011”.

5 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
6 subsection (a) shall take effect as if included in the enact-
7 ment of section 803(a)(1)(B) of the Postal Accountability
8 and Enhancement Act (Public Law 109–435; 120 Stat.
9 3251).
