Mr. GRIFFIN of Arkansas introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To give priority to local and State artists when selecting appropriate artwork for Federal buildings.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Hometown Artists Act
5 of 2011”.

6 **SEC. 2. SELECTION OF ARTISTS FOR GSA ART-IN-ARCHI-**
7 **TECTURE PROGRAM.**

8 (a) PRIORITY FOR LOCAL AND STATE ARTISTS.—To
9 the maximum extent practicable, the Administrator of the
10 General Service Administration (hereinafter referred to in

1 this section as the “Administrator”) shall give priority to
2 local and State artists when selecting appropriate artwork
3 for Federal buildings.

4 (b) EXCEPTION FOR DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA.—Sub-
5 section (a) shall not apply to artwork selected for Federal
6 buildings located in the District of Columbia.

7 (c) REGULATIONS.—Not later than 90 days after the
8 date of the enactment of this Act, the Administrator shall
9 by rule amend such Federal regulations as required to
10 make such regulations consistent with this section.
