**AN ACT**

To direct the Securities and Exchange Commission to eliminate the prohibition against general solicitation as a requirement for a certain exemption under Regulation D.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4        This Act may be cited as the “Access to Capital for  
5 Job Creators Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. MODIFICATION OF EXEMPTION.**

7        (a) REMOVAL OF RESTRICTION.—Section 4(2) of the  
8 Securities Act of 1933 (15 U.S.C. 77d(2)) is amended by  
9 adding before the period the following: “, whether or not

1 such transactions involve general solicitation or general  
2 advertising”.

3 (b) MODIFICATION OF RULES.—Not later than 90  
4 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secu-  
5 rities and Exchange Commission shall revise its rules  
6 issued in section 230.506 of title 17, Code of Federal Reg-  
7 ulations, to provide that the prohibition against general  
8 solicitation or general advertising contained in section  
9 230.502(c) of such title shall not apply to offers and sales  
10 of securities made pursuant to section 230.506, provided  
11 that all purchasers of the securities are accredited inves-  
12 tors. Such rules shall require the issuer to take reasonable  
13 steps to verify that purchasers of the securities are accred-  
14 ited investors, using such methods as determined by the  
15 Commission.
