## A BILL

To amend the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to suspend temporarily the process of imposing restructuring sanctions on such schools and local educational agencies.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4        This Act may be cited as the “School and Local Edu-  
5        cational Agency Resources Efficiency Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF IMPOSING SANC-**  
2 **TIONS ON SUCH SCHOOLS AND LOCAL EDU-**  
3 **CATIONAL AGENCIES.**

4 Section 1116 of the Elementary and Secondary Edu-  
5 cation Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 6316) is amended by add-  
6 ing at the end of the following:

7 “(i) TEMPORARY SUSPENSION.—

8 “(1) SUSPENSION.—Beginning in the 2011–  
9 2012 school year through the date described in para-  
10 graph (2), a school or local educational agency shall  
11 not be identified for restructuring under this section,  
12 and restructuring shall not be required by reason of  
13 being so identified, except that a school or local edu-  
14 cational agency that as of the end of the 2011–2012  
15 school has been identified for corrective action or re-  
16 structuring under this section may continue to be so  
17 identified and be subject to any specific corrective  
18 action or restructuring that was required, as of the  
19 date of enactment of the School and Local Edu-  
20 cational Agency Resources Efficiency Act, by reason  
21 of being so identified.

22 “(2) SUNSET.—Paragraph (1) shall cease to  
23 apply beginning on the earlier of—

24 “(A) the last day of the 2012–2013 school  
25 year; or

1                   “(B) the date of the enactment of an Act  
2                   reauthorizing this Act.”.
