## A BILL

To prohibit the Internal Revenue Service from hiring new employees to enforce the Federal Government's invasion into the health care lives of American citizens.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Prevent IRS Overreach  
5 Act of 2011".

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON IRS FROM HIRING NEW EMPLOY-**  
2 **EES TO ENFORCE PATIENT PROTECTION AND**  
3 **AFFORDABLE CARE ACT AND HEALTH CARE**  
4 **AND EDUCATION RECONCILIATION ACT OF**  
5 **2010.**

6 No position within the Internal Revenue Service may  
7 be filled, by transfer or any other appointment taking ef-  
8 fect on or after the date of enactment of this Act, if the  
9 duties and responsibilities of such position include the en-  
10 forcement of any provision of, or amendment made by, the  
11 Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act or the Health  
12 Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010.
