## A BILL

To adjust the boundary of the Carson National Forest, New Mexico.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Carson National For-  
5 est Boundary Adjustment Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. CARSON NATIONAL FOREST BOUNDARY ADJUST-**  
7 **MENT.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—The boundary of the Carson Na-  
9 tional Forest in the State of New Mexico is adjusted to  
10 incorporate the approximately 4,990 acres of land gen-  
11 erally depicted as “Miranda Canyon Boundary” on the

1 map entitled “Carson National Forest Boundary Adjust-  
2 ment” and dated September 21, 2010.

3 (b) LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND.—For  
4 purposes of section 7 of the Land and Water Conservation  
5 Fund Act of 1965 (16 U.S.C. 460 1–9), the boundaries  
6 of the Carson National Forest, as modified under sub-  
7 section (a), shall be considered to be the boundaries of  
8 the Carson National Forest as in existence on January  
9 1, 1965.
