A BILL

To amend the Abraham Lincoln Commemorative Coin Act to adjust how surcharges are distributed.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DISTRIBUTION OF SURCHARGES.**

4 Section 7(b) of the Abraham Lincoln Commemorative
5 Coin Act is amended by striking “to the Abraham Lincoln
6 Bicentennial Commission to further the work of the Com-
7 mission” and inserting the following:

8 “as follows:

9 “(1) The first \$2,000,000, to the Abraham Lin-
10 coln Bicentennial foundation, to further its work.

1 “(2) Of any amounts above \$2,000,000, equal
2 amounts to the following:

3 “(A) Ford’s Theater, to maintain and pre-
4 serve the building and its contents.

5 “(B) President Lincoln’s Cottage at the
6 Soldiers’ Home, to maintain and preserve the
7 building and its contents.

8 “(C) The Abraham Lincoln Presidential
9 Library and Museum, for maintenance of the li-
10 brary and museum and their contents.”.
