To allow an occupancy preference for veterans in housing projects developed on property of the Department of Veterans Affairs with assistance provided under the Department of Housing and Urban Development program for supportive housing for very low-income elderly persons.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Senior Veterans Hous-
5 ing Assistance Act of 2011”.

1 **SEC. 2. OCCUPANCY PREFERENCE FOR VETERANS.**

2 Notwithstanding section 202 of the Housing Act of
3 1959 (12 U.S.C. 1701q) or any other provision of law ap-
4 plicable to assistance under such section or to a project
5 assisted under such section, a preference may be estab-
6 lished for occupancy by veterans who are very low-income
7 elderly persons in dwelling units in any supportive housing
8 project for the elderly that—

9 (1) is provided assistance under such section by
10 the Department of Housing and Urban Develop-
11 ment; and

12 (2)(A) is or would be located on property of the
13 Department of Veterans Affairs; or

14 (B) is subject to an enhanced use lease with the
15 Department of Veterans Affairs.
