A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. JOHN M. ROLL UNITED STATES COURTHOUSE.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The United States courthouse
5 under construction, as of the date of enactment of this
6 Act, at 98 West First Street, Yuma, Arizona, shall be
7 known and designated as the “John M. Roll United States
8 Courthouse”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the United States courthouse referred to in sub-
4 section (a) shall be deemed to be a reference to the “John
5 M. Roll United States Courthouse”.
