A BILL

To extend the Andean Trade Preference Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF ANDEAN TRADE PREFERENCE**

4 **ACT.**

5 (a) EXTENSION.—Section 208(a) of the Andean
6 Trade Preference Act (19 U.S.C. 3206(a)) is amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (1)(A), by striking “February
8 12, 2011” and inserting “June 30, 2011”; and

1 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “February 12,
2 2011” and inserting “June 30, 2011”.

3 (b) TREATMENT OF CERTAIN APPAREL ARTICLES.—
4 Section 204(b)(3)(E)(ii)(II) of the Andean Trade Pref-
5 erence Act (19 U.S.C. 3203(b)(3)(E)(II)) is amended by
6 striking “February 12, 2011” and inserting “June 30,
7 2011”.

8 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
9 this section shall take effect on February 13, 2011.

10 **SEC. 2. OFFSET.**

11 Section 279(b) of the Trade Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C.
12 2372a(b)) is amended by striking “2013, and 2014” and
13 inserting “and 2013 and \$469,000,000 for fiscal year
14 2014”.

15 **SEC. 3. COMPLIANCE WITH PAYGO.**

16 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of
17 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010,
18 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement
19 titled “Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation” for this
20 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record
21 by the Chairman of the House Budget Committee, pro-
22 vided that such statement has been submitted prior to the
23 vote on passage.
