A BILL

To deauthorize and rescind funding for the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act and health-care-related provisions of the Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DEFUNDING HEALTH CARE REFORM.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no funds
5 are authorized to be appropriated to carry out the provi-
6 sions of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act

1 (Public Law 111–148), the provisions of title I and sub-
2 title B of title III of the Health Care and Education Rec-
3 onciliation Act of 2010 (Public Law 111–152), and any
4 amendment made by any such provision. The unobligated
5 balances of funds appropriated to carry out such provi-
6 sions are hereby rescinded.

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
