1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ST. CROIX RIVER CROSSING PROJECT.**

4 *Notwithstanding section 7(a) of the Wild and Scenic*
5 *Rivers Act (16 U.S.C. 1278(a)), the head of any Federal*
6 *agency or department may authorize and assist in the con-*
7 *struction of a new extradosed bridge crossing the St. Croix*
8 *River approximately 6 miles north of the I-94 crossing, if*
9 *the mitigation items described in paragraph 9 of the 2006*
10 *St. Croix River Crossing Project Memorandum of Under-*
11 *standing for Implementation of Riverway Mitigation Items,*
12 *signed by the Federal Highway Administration on March*
13 *28, 2006, and by the National Park Service on March 27,*
14 *2006 (including any subsequent amendments to the Memo-*
15 *randum of Understanding), are included as enforceable con-*
16 *ditions.*
