To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to broaden the special rules for certain governmental plans under section 105(j) to include plans established by political subdivisions.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXPANSION OF APPLICATION OF SPECIAL**
4 **RULES FOR CERTAIN GOVERNMENTAL PLANS**
5 **TO INCLUDE PLANS ESTABLISHED BY POLIT-**
6 **ICAL SUBDIVISIONS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 105(j)(2) of the Internal
8 Revenue Code of 1986 is amended—

1 (1) by inserting “or established by or on behalf
2 of a State or political subdivision thereof” after
3 “public retirement system”, and

4 (2) by inserting “or 501(c)(9)” after “section
5 115” in subparagraph (B) thereof.

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
7 this section shall apply to payments after the date of the
8 enactment of this Act.
