To amend title 38, United States Code, to provide for coverage under the beneficiary travel program of the Department of Veterans Affairs of certain disabled veterans for travel for certain special disabilities rehabilitation, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. COVERAGE UNDER DEPARTMENT OF VET-**
2 **ERANS AFFAIRS BENEFICIARY TRAVEL PRO-**
3 **GRAM OF CERTAIN DISABLED VETERANS FOR**
4 **TRAVEL FOR CERTAIN SPECIAL DISABILITIES**
5 **REHABILITATION.**

6 Section 111(b)(1) of title 38, United States Code, is
7 amended by adding at the end the following new subpara-
8 graph:

9 “(G) A veteran with vision impairment, a vet-
10 eran with a spinal cord injury or disorder, or a vet-
11 eran with double or multiple amputations whose
12 travel is in connection with in-patient care in a spe-
13 cial disabilities rehabilitation program of the Depart-
14 ment.”.
