A BILL

To amend the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act to suspend a limitation on the period for which certain borrowers are eligible for guaranteed assistance.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF LIMITATION ON PERIOD FOR**
4 **WHICH BORROWERS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR**
5 **GUARANTEED ASSISTANCE.**

6 Section 319(b) of the Consolidated Farm and Rural
7 Development Act (7 U.S.C. 1949(b)) is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “paragraph
2 (2)” and inserting “paragraphs (2) and (3)”; and
3 (2) by adding at the end the following:
4 “(3) SUSPENSION.—During the period begin-
5 ning December 31, 2010, and ending December 31,
6 2013, paragraph (1) shall have no force or effect.”.
