- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Combating Dangerous
- 5 Synthetic Stimulants Act of 2011".

1 SEC. 2. CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ACT.

- 2 Schedule I of section 202(c) of the Controlled Sub-
- 3 stances Act (21 U.S.C. 812(c)) is amended in subsection
- 4 (c) by adding at the end the following:
- 5 "(18) 4-methylmethcathinone (Mephedrone).
- 6 "(19) 3,4-methylenedioxypyrovalerone
- 7 (MDPV).".
