Mr. BROWN of Ohio introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To improve the Fugitive Safe Surrender Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FUGITIVE SAFE SURRENDER PROGRAM.**

4 Section 632 of the Adam Walsh Child Protection and
5 Safety Act of 2006 (42 U.S.C. 16989) is amended—

6 (1) in subsection (a)(1), by striking “Fugitive
7 Safe Surrender is a program of the United States
8 Marshals Service” and inserting “Since its creation
9 in 2005, the Fugitive Safe Surrender program has
10 been operated by the United States Marshals Serv-
11 ice”;

1 (2) in subsection (b), by striking “United
2 States Marshals Service” each place it appears and
3 inserting “Attorney General”; and

4 (3) in subsection (c), by striking “United States
5 Marshals Service” and all that follows and inserting
6 “Attorney General to carry out this section
7 \$5,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2012 through
8 2016.”.
