A BILL

Making supplemental appropriations for the Army Corps of Engineers for flood control projects and storm damage reduction projects in areas affected by flooding in the city of Houston, Texas, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following sums are appropriated, out of any
4 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the
5 fiscal year ending September 30, 2016:

1 DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY
2 CORPS OF ENGINEERS-CIVIL
3 CONSTRUCTION

4 For an additional amount for “Construction” for
5 flood control projects and storm damage reduction
6 projects in areas affected by flooding in the city of Hous-
7 ton, Texas, that have received a major disaster declaration
8 pursuant to the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and
9 Emergency Assistance Act, \$311,000,000, to remain
10 available through fiscal year 2026: *Provided*, That such
11 amount is designated by the Congress as being for disaster
12 relief pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(D) of the Balanced
13 Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985.

14 This Act may be cited as the “2016 Tax Day Floods
15 Supplemental Funding Act”.
