1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TECHNICAL AMENDMENT.**

4 Section 3 of the Barrow Gas Field Transfer Act of
5 1984 (Public Law 98–366, 98 Stat. 468) is amended by
6 adding at the end the following: “The foregoing convey-
7 ance to UIC shall include all right, title, and interest held
8 by the United States to sand and gravel deposits under-

1 lying the surface estate owned by UIC contiguous to the
2 Barrow gas fields, more particularly described as the sand
3 and gravel deposits underlying that UIC surface estate
4 lying within T 21N R16W, sections 7, 17-18, 19-21, and
5 28-29; T 21N R17W, sections 1-2, and 11-14; T 22N,
6 R18W, sections 4, 9, and 29-32; and T 22N R19W, sec-
7 tions 25 and 36.”.

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
