Mr. GRAVES of Louisiana (for himself, Mr. BOUSTANY, Mr. RICHMOND, and Mr. ABRAHAM) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Financial Services

A BILL

To establish a deadline for approval of claims made under the National Flood Insurance Program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Timely Payments for
5 Flood Victims Act of 2016”.

6 **SEC. 2. DEADLINE FOR APPROVAL OF CLAIMS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1312 of the National
8 Flood Insurance Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 4019) is amend-
9 ed—

1 (1) in subsection (a), by striking “The Adminis-
2 trator” and inserting “Subject to other provisions of
3 this section, the Administrator”; and

4 (2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
5 section:

6 “(d) DEADLINE FOR APPROVAL OF CLAIMS.—

7 “(1) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator shall
8 provide that, in the case of any claim for damage to
9 or loss of property under flood insurance coverage
10 made available under this title, a final determination
11 regarding approval of a claim for payment or dis-
12 approval of the claim be made, and notification of
13 such determination be provided to the insured mak-
14 ing such claim, not later than the expiration of the
15 30-day period (as such period may be extended pur-
16 suant to paragraph (2)) beginning upon the day on
17 which such claim was made. Payment of approved
18 claims shall be made as soon as possible after such
19 approval.

20 “(2) EXTENSION OF DEADLINE.—The Adminis-
21 trator shall provide that the period referred to in
22 paragraph (1) may be extended by a single addi-
23 tional period of 15 days in cases where extraordinary
24 circumstances are demonstrated. The Administrator
25 shall, by regulation, establish criteria for dem-

1 onstrating such extraordinary circumstances and for
2 determining to which claims such extraordinary cir-
3 cumstances apply.”.

4 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by sub-
5 section (a) shall apply to any claim under flood insurance
6 coverage made available under the National Flood Insur-
7 ance Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 4001 et seq.) pending on
8 the date of the enactment of this Act and any claims made
9 after such date of enactment.
