A BILL

To ensure that Federal funding for the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change complies with applicable statutory limitations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Limiting Contributions
5 to the United Nations and Affiliated Organizations that
6 Accord the Palestine Liberation Organization the Same
7 Standing as Member States Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. FUNDING LIMITATION.**

2 The Secretary of State shall ensure that the use of
3 any Federal funding to support the United Nations
4 Framework Convention on Climate Change, including the
5 Green Climate Fund, complies with applicable Federal
6 law, including—

7 (1) section 8 of the United Nations Participa-
8 tion Act of 1945 (22 U.S.C. 287e);

9 (2) section 414 of the Foreign Relations Au-
10 thorization Act, Fiscal Years 1990 and 1991 (Public
11 Law 101–246); and

12 (3) section 410 of the Foreign Relations Au-
13 thorization Act, Fiscal Years 1994 and 1995 (Public
14 Law 103–236).
