A BILL

To amend the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act to require regulated entities to provide information necessary for the Offices of Women and Minority Inclusion to carry out their duties, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 ***SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.***

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Diversity and Inclusion*
5 *Data Accountability and Transparency Act of 2021”.*

6 ***SEC. 2. DISCLOSURES BY REGULATED ENTITIES.***

7 *Section 342(b) of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform*
8 *and Consumer Protection Act (12 U.S.C. 5452(b)) is*
9 *amended by adding at the end the following:*

10 “(5) *DISCLOSURES BY REGULATED ENTITIES.—*

11 *The Director of each Office shall require entities with*
12 *100 employees or greater regulated by the applicable*
13 *agency to provide such information as may be re-*
14 *quired to carry out the duties of the Director.”.*

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
