AN ACT

To designate and adjust certain lands in the State of Utah
as components of the National Wilderness Preservation
System, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Bonneville Shoreline
3 Trail Advancement Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. WILDERNESS AREA INCLUDED IN MOUNT OLYMPUS**
5 **WILDERNESS.**

6 Section 102(a) of the Utah Wilderness Act of 1984
7 (Public Law 98–428; 98 Stat. 1657; 16 U.S.C. 1132 note)
8 is amended—

9 (1) in paragraph (11), by striking “and” at the
10 end;

11 (2) in paragraph (12), by striking the period at
12 the end and inserting “; and”; and

13 (3) by adding at the end the following:

14 “(13) certain lands in the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache
15 National Forest which comprise approximately
16 326.27 acres as generally depicted on a map entitled
17 the ‘Bonneville Shoreline Trail Legislative Map’
18 dated July 9, 2020, are, subject to valid existing
19 rights, hereby incorporated as part of the Mount
20 Olympus Wilderness designated under paragraph
21 (3).”.

22 **SEC. 3. WILDERNESS BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENTS.**

23 (a) MOUNT NAOMI WILDERNESS BOUNDARY AD-
24 JUSTMENT.—

25 (1) ADJUSTMENT.—Section 102 of the Utah
26 Wilderness Act of 1984 (Public Law 98–428, 98

1 Stat. 1657, 16 U.S.C. 1132 note) is amended by
2 adding at the end the following:

3 “(c) MOUNT NAOMI WILDERNESS BOUNDARY AD-
4 JUSTMENT.—Certain lands in the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache
5 National Forest which comprise approximately 11.17
6 acres as generally depicted on a map entitled the ‘Bonne-
7 ville Shoreline Trail Legislative Map’, dated July 9, 2020,
8 are hereby removed from the Mount Naomi Wilderness
9 designated under subsection (a)(1).”.

10 (2) MANAGEMENT.—The Mount Naomi Wilder-
11 ness, as designated under section 102(a)(1) of the
12 Utah Wilderness Act of 1984 (Public Law 98–428;
13 98 Stat. 1658; 16 U.S.C. 1132 note) and adjusted
14 under paragraph (1), effective beginning on the date
15 of the enactment of this Act, shall be managed as
16 part of the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest.

17 (b) MOUNT OLYMPUS WILDERNESS BOUNDARY AD-
18 JUSTMENT.—

19 (1) ADJUSTMENT.—Section 102 of the Utah
20 Wilderness Act of 1984 (Public Law 98–428; 98
21 Stat. 1657; 16 U.S.C. 1132 note), as amended by
22 subsection (a), is further amended by adding the at
23 the end the following:

24 “(d) MOUNT OLYMPUS WILDERNESS BOUNDARY AD-
25 JUSTMENT.—Certain lands in the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache

1 National Forest which comprise approximately 197.4
2 acres as generally depicted on a map entitled the ‘Bonne-
3 ville Shoreline Trail Legislative Map’, dated July 9, 2020,
4 are hereby removed from the Mount Olympus Wilderness
5 designated under subsection (a)(3).”.

6 (2) MANAGEMENT.—The Mount Olympus Wil-
7 derness, as designated under section 102(a)(3) of
8 the Utah Wilderness Act of 1984 (Public Law 98–
9 428; 98 Stat. 1658; 16 U.S.C. 1132 note) and ad-
10 justed under paragraph (1), effective beginning on
11 the date of the enactment of this Act, shall be man-
12 aged as part of the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National
13 Forest.

14 (c) TWIN PEAKS WILDERNESS BOUNDARY ADJUST-
15 MENT.—

16 (1) ADJUSTMENT.—Section 102 of the Utah
17 Wilderness Act of 1984 (Public Law 98–428, 98
18 Stat. 1657, 16 U.S.C. 1132 note), as amended by
19 subsections (a) and (b), is further amended by add-
20 ing at the end the following:

21 “(e) TWIN PEAKS WILDERNESS BOUNDARY ADJUST-
22 MENT.—Certain lands in the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache Na-
23 tional Forest which comprise approximately 9.8 acres as
24 generally depicted on a map entitled the ‘Bonneville
25 Shoreline Trail Legislative Map’, dated July 9, 2020, are

1 hereby removed from the Twin Peaks Wilderness des-
2 ignated under subsection (a)(4).”.

3 (2) MANAGEMENT.—The Twin Peaks Wilder-
4 ness, as designated under section 102(a)(4) of the
5 Utah Wilderness Act of 1984 (Public Law 98–428;
6 98 Stat. 1658; 16 U.S.C. 1132 note) and adjusted
7 under paragraph (1), effective beginning on the date
8 of the enactment of this Act, shall be managed as
9 part of the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest.

10 (d) LONE PEAK WILDERNESS BOUNDARY ADJUST-
11 MENT.—

12 (1) ADJUSTMENT.—Section 2 of the Endan-
13 gered American Wilderness Act of 1978 (Public Law
14 95–237; 92 Stat. 42; 16 U.S.C. 1132 note) is
15 amended—

16 (A) in subsection (j), by striking “and” at
17 the end;

18 (B) in subsection (k), by striking the pe-
19 riod at the end and inserting “; and”; and

20 (C) by adding at the end the following:

21 “(l) certain lands in the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache Na-
22 tional Forest, Utah, which comprise approximately 107.9
23 acres as generally depicted on a map entitled the ‘Bonne-
24 ville Shoreline Trail Legislative Map’, dated July 9, 2020,

1 are hereby removed from the Lone Peak Wilderness Area
2 designated under subsection (i).”.

3 (2) MANAGEMENT.—The Lone Peak Wilderness
4 Area, as designated under section 2(i) of the Endan-
5 gered American Wilderness Act of 1978 (Public Law
6 95–237; 92 Stat. 42; 16 U.S.C. 1132 note) and ad-
7 justed under paragraph (1), effective beginning on
8 the date of the enactment of this Act, shall be man-
9 aged as part of the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National
10 Forest.

11 **SEC. 4. RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.**

12 Nothing in this Act or the amendments made by this
13 Act—

14 (1) affects the use or allocation, in existence on
15 the date of enactment of this Act, of any water,
16 water right, or interest in water;

17 (2) affects any water right (as defined by appli-
18 cable State law) in existence on the date of enact-
19 ment of this Act, including any water right held by
20 the United States;

21 (3) affects any interstate water compact in ex-
22 istence on the date of enactment of this Act; or

23 (4) shall be considered to be a relinquishment
24 or reduction of any water rights reserved or appro-

(a) MAP ON FILE.—The map entitled the “Bonneville
Shoreline Trail Legislative Map”, dated July 9, 2020,
shall be on file and available for inspection in the office
of the Chief of the Forest Service.

8 (b) CORRECTIONS.—The Secretary of Agriculture
9 may make technical corrections to the map described in
10 subsection (a).
