AN ACT

To amend the First Step Act of 2018 to permit defendants convicted of certain offenses to be eligible for reduced sentences, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Terry Technical Cor-
3 rection Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. APPLICATION OF FAIR SENTENCING ACT OF 2010.**

5 Section 404 of the First Step Act of 2018 (21 U.S.C.
6 841 note) is amended—

7 (1) in subsection (a)—

8 (A) by striking “‘covered offense’ means”
9 and inserting the following:

10 “‘covered offense’—

11 “(1) means”;

12 (B) by striking the period at the end and
13 inserting “; and”; and

14 (C) by adding at the end the following:

15 “(2) includes a violation, involving cocaine base,
16 of—

17 “(A) section 3113 of title 5, United States
18 Code;

19 “(B) section 401(b)(1)(C) of the Con-
20 trolled Substances Act (21 U.S.C.
21 841(b)(1)(C));

22 “(C) section 404(a) of the Controlled Sub-
23 stances Act (21 U.S.C. 844(a));

24 “(D) section 406 of the Controlled Sub-
25 stances Act (21 U.S.C. 846);

1 “(E) section 408 of the Controlled Sub-
2 stances Act (21 U.S.C. 848);

3 “(F) subsection (b) or (c) of section 409 of
4 the Controlled Substances Act (21 U.S.C. 849);

5 “(G) subsection (a) or (b) of section 418
6 of the Controlled Substances Act (21 U.S.C.
7 859);

8 “(H) subsection (a), (b), or (c) of section
9 419 of the Controlled Substances Act (21
10 U.S.C. 860);

11 “(I) section 420 of the Controlled Sub-
12 stances Act (21 U.S.C. 861);

13 “(J) section 1010(b)(3) of the Controlled
14 Substances Import and Export Act (21 U.S.C.
15 960(b)(3));

16 “(K) section 1010A of the Controlled Sub-
17 stances Import and Export Act (21 U.S.C.
18 960a);

19 “(L) section 90103 of the Violent Crime
20 Control and Law Enforcement Act of 1994 (34
21 U.S.C. 12522);

22 “(M) section 70503 or 70506 of title 46,
23 United States Code; or
