AN ACT

To amend the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act to make technical corrections to the hazard mitigation revolving loan fund program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Safeguarding Tomorrow through Ongoing Risk Mitigation Technical Corrections Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO HAZARD MITIGATION**
6 **REVOLVING LOAN FUND PROGRAM.**

7 Section 205 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief
8 and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5135) is
9 amended—

10 (1) in subsection (d)—

11 (A) in paragraph (2)—

12 (i) by striking subparagraph (C);

13 (ii) at the end of subparagraph (A),
14 by adding “and”; and

15 (iii) at the end of subparagraph (B),
16 by striking “; and” and inserting a period;

17 (B) in paragraph (3)(D), by striking “local
18 governments, insular areas, and Indian tribal
19 governments” and inserting “local governments
20 and Tribal governments”; and

21 (C) by striking paragraph (4);

22 (2) in subsection (f)—

23 (A) in paragraph (4)—

24 (i) by striking subparagraph (B); and

1 (ii) by redesignating subparagraphs
2 (C) through (D) as subparagraphs (B)
3 through (C), respectively; and
4 (B) in paragraph (5)—

5 (i) in the paragraph heading, by strik-
6 ing “ESTABLISHING” and inserting “IM-
7 PLEMENTING”;

8 (ii) by striking “establish” and insert-
9 ing “implement”;

10 (iii) by inserting “2” after “latest”;
11 and

12 (iv) by inserting “, including any
13 amendments made by State, local, Tribal,
14 or territorial governments to such codes,
15 specifications, and standards,” after
16 “standards”; and

17 (3) in subsection (m)—

18 (A) by striking paragraph (3) and insert-
19 ing the following:

20 “(3) ELIGIBLE ENTITY.—The term ‘eligible en-
21 tity’ means a State or an Indian tribal government
22 that has received a major disaster declaration pursu-
23 ant to section 401.”;

24 (B) by striking paragraphs (5) and (10);
