3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “District of Columbia
5 Bridges Home Rule Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF SPECIFIC CRIMINAL PENALTY FOR OB-**
2 **STRUCTING BRIDGE BETWEEN DISTRICT OF**
3 **COLUMBIA AND VIRGINIA.**

4 Section 11712(e) of the National Capital Revitaliza-
5 tion and Self-Government Improvement Act of 1997 (sec.
6 22–1323, D.C. Official Code) is repealed.

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
