AN ACT

To exclude government officials of the Russian Federation from certain international meetings, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Isolate Russian Gov-
3 ernment Officials Act of 2022”.

4 **SEC. 2. EXCLUSION OF GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS OF THE**
5 **RUSSIAN FEDERATION.**

6 (a) **POLICY OF THE UNITED STATES.**—It is the pol-
7 icy of the United States to seek to exclude government
8 officials of the Russian Federation, to the maximum ex-
9 tent practicable, from participation in meetings, pro-
10 ceedings, and other activities of the following organiza-
11 tions:

- 12 (1) Group of 20.
13 (2) Bank for International Settlements.
14 (3) Basel Committee for Banking Standards.
15 (4) Financial Stability Board.
16 (5) International Association of Insurance Su-
17 pervisors.
18 (6) International Organization of Securities
19 Commissions.

20 (b) **IMPLEMENTATION.**—The Secretary of the Treas-
21 ury, the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve Sys-
22 tem, and the Securities and Exchange Commission, as the
23 case may be, shall take all necessary steps to advance the
24 policy set forth in subsection (a).

25 (c) **TERMINATION.**—This section shall have no force
26 or effect on the earlier of—

(2) 30 days after the date that the President reports to Congress that the government of the Russian Federation has ceased its destabilizing activities with respect to the sovereignty and territorial integrity of Ukraine.

(d) WAIVER.—The President may waive the applica-
tion of this section if the President reports to the Congress
that the waiver is in the national interest of the United
States and includes an explanation of the reasons therefor.
