AN ACT

To amend the National Trails System Act to direct the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a study on the feasibility of designating the Chief Standing Bear National Historic Trail, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. CHIEF STANDING BEAR NATIONAL HISTORIC**
2 **TRAIL FEASIBILITY STUDY.**

3 Section 5(c) of the National Trails System Act (16
4 U.S.C. 1244(c)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
5 lowing:

6 “(xx) CHIEF STANDING BEAR NATIONAL HIS-
7 TORIC TRAIL.—The Chief Standing Bear Trail, ex-
8 tending approximately 550 miles from Niobrara, Ne-
9 braska, to Ponca City, Oklahoma, which follows the
10 route taken by Chief Standing Bear and the Ponca
11 people during Federal Indian removal, and approxi-
12 mately 550 miles from Ponca City, Oklahoma,
13 through Omaha, Nebraska, to Niobrara, Nebraska,
14 which follows the return route taken by Chief Stand-
15 ing Bear and the Ponca people.”.

Passed the House of Representatives May 12, 2021.
