A BILL

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to make inadmissible past representatives or members of terrorist organizations, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Preventing Terrorist
5 Entry Act of 2022”.

6 **SEC. 2. INADMISSIBILITY OF PAST REPRESENTATIVES OR**
7 **MEMBERS OF TERRORIST ORGANIZATIONS.**

8 Section 212(a)(3)(B)(i) (8 U.S.C. 1182(a)(3)(B)(i))
9 of the Immigration and Nationality Act is amended—

1 (1) in subclause (IV) (in the matter preceding
2 item (aa)), by inserting “or has been” before “a rep-
3 resentative”;

4 (2) in subclause (V), by inserting the term “or
5 has been” before “a member”; and

6 (3) in subclause (VI), by inserting the term “or
7 has been” before “a member”.

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
