Mr. DAINES introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

A BILL

To suspend any funding authorized under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 from any State government that provides monetary payments to undocumented immigrants and to require States to reimburse the Federal Government for any such payments made since the date of the enactment of such Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Taxpayer Hand-
5 outs to Illegal Immigrants Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. SUSPENSION OF CERTAIN FUNDING FROM STATES**
2 **THAT PROVIDE MONETARY PAYMENTS TO**
3 **UNDOCUMENTED IMMIGRANTS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
5 sion of law, no funds made available under the American
6 Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (Public Law 117–2) may be
7 made available to any State government that directly or
8 indirectly provides monetary payments to undocumented
9 immigrants.

10 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The restriction under sub-
11 section (a) shall apply to any funds made available under
12 the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 on or after the
13 date of the enactment of this Act.

14 (c) CLAWBACK PROVISION.—If any State government
15 described in subsection (a) provided monetary payments
16 (directly or indirectly) to undocumented immigrants dur-
17 ing the period beginning on the date of the enactment of
18 the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 and ending on the
19 date of the enactment of this Act, the State shall imme-
20 diately submit payment to the Treasury of the United
21 States in an amount equal to the aggregate total of such
22 monetary payments.
