3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Metropolitan Statis-
5 tical Area Stabilization Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION AND STUDY ON METROPOLITAN STA-**
2 **TISTICAL AREA DESIGNATION.**

3 The Director of the Office of Management and Budg-
4 et shall not raise the minimum urban area population to
5 qualify a metropolitan statistical area from 50,000.
