A BILL

To provide for the crediting of funds received by the National
Guard Bureau as reimbursement from States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Guarding Readiness
5 Resources Act of 2021”.

1 **SEC. 2. TREATMENT OF FUNDS RECEIVED BY NATIONAL**
2 **GUARD BUREAU AS REIMBURSEMENT FROM**
3 **STATES.**

4 Section 710 of title 32, United States Code, is
5 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
6 section:

7 “(g) TREATMENT OF REIMBURSED FUNDS.—Any
8 funds received by the National Guard Bureau from a
9 State, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, the District of
10 Columbia, Guam, or the Virgin Islands as reimbursement
11 under this section for the use of military property shall
12 be credited to—

13 “(1) the appropriation, fund, or account used in
14 incurring the obligation; or

15 “(2) an appropriate appropriation, fund, or ac-
16 count currently available for the purposes for which
17 the expenditures were made.”.

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
