To amend title XIX of the Social Security Act to enable greater participation by seniors and Medicare beneficiaries in State Medicaid programs for working people with disabilities.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Supporting and Em-
5 powering the Nation to Improve Outcomes that Reaffirm
6 Careers, Activities, and Recreation for the Elderly Act”,
7 or the “SENIOR CARE Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ALLOWING SENIORS AND MEDICARE BENE-**
2 **FICIARIES TO PARTICIPATE IN STATE MED-**
3 **ICAID PROGRAMS FOR WORKING PEOPLE**
4 **WITH DISABILITIES.**

5 Title XIX of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396
6 et seq.) is amended in sections 1902(a)(10)(A)(ii)(XV)
7 and 1905(v)(1)(A) by striking “, but less than 65,” each
