#### AN ACT

To require the Director of National Intelligence to declassify information relating to the origin of COVID-19, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

#### SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2	This Act may be cited as the "COVID-19 Origin Act
3	of 2021".

- 5 Congress makes the following findings:
- 6 (1) The Department of State released a fact 7 sheet on January 15, 2021, about the Wuhan Insti-8 tute of Virology (WIV) which stated the following:
  - (A) "The U.S. government has reason to believe that several researchers inside the WIV became sick in autumn 2019, before the first identified case of the outbreak, with symptoms consistent with both COVID-19 and common seasonal illnesses.".
    - (B) "WIV researchers conducted experiments involving RaTG13, the bat coronavirus identified by the WIV in January 2020 as its closest sample to SARS-CoV-2.".
  - (C) "Despite the WIV presenting itself as a civilian institution, the United States has determined that the WIV has collaborated on publications and secret projects with China's military.".
  - (2) Former Director of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Robert Redfield, stated in March 2021 that, "the most likely etiology of this

- pathogen in Wuhan was from a laboratory" and noted that, "[i]t is not unusual for respiratory pathogens that are being worked on in a laboratory to infect the laboratory worker.".
- 5 (3) Director-General of the World Health Orga6 nization Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus acknowl7 edged in March 2021 that the Coronavirus Disease
  8 2019 (COVID-19) may have originated in a labora9 tory and said this hypothesis "requires further inves10 tigation, potentially with additional missions involv11 ing specialist experts.".

#### 12 SEC. 3. SENSE OF CONGRESS.

- 13 It is the sense of Congress that—
- 14 (1) identifying the origin of Coronavirus Dis-15 ease 2019 (COVID-19) is critical for preventing a 16 similar pandemic from occurring in the future;
  - (2) there is reason to believe the COVID-19 pandemic may have originated at the Wuhan Institute of Virology; and
  - (3) the Director of National Intelligence should declassify and make available to the public as much information as possible about the origin of COVID—19 so the United States and like-minded countries

6	SEC. 4. DECLASSIFICATION OF INFORMATION RELATED TO					
7	THE ORIGIN OF COVID-19.					
8	Not later than 90 days after the date of the enact-					
9	ment of this Act, the Director of National Intelligence					
10	shall—					
11	(1) declassify any and all information relating					
12	to potential links between the Wuhan Institute of Vi-					
13	rology and the origin of the Coronavirus Disease					
14	2019 (COVID-19), including—					
15	(A) activities performed by the Wuhan In-					
16	stitute of Virology with or on behalf of the Peo-					
17	ple's Liberation Army;					
18	(B) coronavirus research or other related					
19	activities performed at the Wuhan Institute of					
20	Virology prior to the outbreak of COVID-19;					
21	and					
22	(C) researchers at the Wuhan Institute of					
23	Virology who fell ill in autumn 2019, including					
24	for any such researcher—					
25	(i) the researcher's name;					

1	(ii) the researcher's symptoms;						
2	(iii) the date of the onset of the re-						
3	searcher's symptoms;						
4	(iv) the researcher's role at the						
5	Wuhan Institute of Virology;						
6	(v) whether the researcher was in-						
7	volved with or exposed to coronavirus re-						
8	search at the Wuhan Institute of Virology;						
9	(vi) whether the researcher visited a						
10	hospital while they were ill; and						
11	(vii) a description of any other actions						
12	taken by the researcher that may suggest						
13	they were experiencing a serious illness at						
14	the time; and						
15	(2) submit to Congress an unclassified report						
16	that contains—						
17	(A) all of the information described under						
18	paragraph (1); and						

1	(B) only such redactions as the Director					
2	determines necessary to protect sources and					
3	methods.
