A BILL

To amend title XVIII to strengthen ambulance services furnished under part B of the Medicare program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE; TABLE OF CONTENTS.**

4 (a) SHORT TITLE.—This Act may be cited as the
5 “Protecting Access to Ground Ambulance Medical Serv-
6 ices Act of 2021”.

6 Section 1834(l) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
7 1395m(l)) is amended—

8 (1) in paragraph (12)(A), by striking “2023”
9 and inserting “2028”; and

10 (2) in paragraph (13)(A), by striking “2023”
11 each place it appears and inserting “2028” in each
12 such place.

16 SEC. 201. PROTECTING ACCESS TO AMBULANCE SERVICES
17 IN RURAL AND LOW POPULATION DENSITY
18 AREAS.

19 Section 1834(l)(12) of the Social Security Act (42
20 U.S.C. 1395m(l)(12)) is amended by adding at the end
21 the following new subparagraphs:

1 “(C) EXCEPTION FOR RURAL AND QUALI-
2 FIED RURAL AREAS.—The Secretary shall deem
3 an area designated as a rural or qualified rural
4 area under this paragraph that would otherwise
5 no longer receive such designation to retain its
6 previous designated status if there are 1,000 or
7 fewer individuals per square mile in the area.

8 “(D) RIGHT TO APPEAL RURAL AREAS
9 AND QUALIFIED RURAL AREAS.—The Secretary
10 shall establish an administrative appeals proc-
11 ess to allow ambulance services providers and
12 suppliers to seek reconsideration of a change in
13 a ZIP code’s status as a rural or qualified rural
14 area during the first 12 months after the Sec-
15 retary finalizes a change in the designation
16 made under this paragraph.”.
