Mr. THUNE (for himself and Mr. KELLY) introduced the following bill; which
was read twice and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security and
Governmental Affairs

A BILL

To appropriately limit the size of the population required
for urban areas of metropolitan statistical areas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Metropolitan Statis-
5 tical Area Preservation Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. POPULATION OF URBAN AREAS.**

7 Section 3504 of title 44, United States Code, is
8 amended by adding at the end the following:

9 “(l) In implementing subsection (e)(3), the Direc-
10 tor—

1 “(1) shall not establish, for purposes of desig-
2 nating areas as metropolitan statistical areas, or any
3 successor thereto, a minimum population for the
4 urban area of such a metropolitan statistical area
5 that is more than 50,000; and

6 “(2) may, only for statistical purposes, and in
7 addition to the minimum population for urban areas
8 described in paragraph (1), establish other statistical
9 area designations with minimum population require-
10 ments for urban areas that are higher than the min-
11 imum population for an urban area described in
12 paragraph (1).”.

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
