A BILL

To extend the trade adjustment assistance program for one
month.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Trade Adjustment As-
5 sistance Extension Act of 2021”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF TRADE ADJUSTMENT ASSISTANCE**
7 **PROGRAM.**

8 (a) EXTENSION OF TERMINATION PROVISIONS.—
9 Section 285 of the Trade Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C. 2271
10 note) is amended by striking “June 30, 2021” each place
11 it appears and inserting “July 23, 2021”.

1 (b) REEMPLOYMENT TRADE ADJUSTMENT ASSIST-
 2 ANCE.—Section 246(b)(1) of the Trade Act of 1974 (19
 3 U.S.C. 2318(b)(1)) is amended by striking “June 30,
 4 2021” and inserting “July 23, 2021”.

5 (c) TRADE ADJUSTMENT ASSISTANCE FOR WORK-
 6 ERS.—Section 245(a) of the Trade Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C.
 7 2317(a)) is amended by striking “June 30, 2021” and in-
 8 serting “July 23, 2021”.

9 (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
 10 this section take effect on the earlier of—

- 11 (1) the date of the enactment of this Act; or
- 12 (2) June 30, 2021.

13 (e) APPLICATION OF PRIOR LAW.—Section 406 of
 14 the Trade Adjustment Assistance Reauthorization Act of
 15 2015 (title IV of Public Law 114–27; 129 Stat. 379; 19
 16 U.S.C. 2271 note prec.) is amended—

17 (1) in subsection (a)—

18 (A) in the matter preceding paragraph (1),
 19 by striking “July 1, 2021” and inserting “July
 20 24, 2021”; and

21 (B) in paragraphs (5) and (6), by striking
 22 “the 1-year period beginning on July 1, 2021”
 23 and inserting “the period beginning on July 24,
 24 2021, and ending on June 30, 2022”; and

1 (2) in subsection (b), by striking “July 1,
2 2021” each place it appears and inserting “July 24,
3 2021”.
