A BILL

To require the Administrator of the Small Business Administration make a technical correction to the Restaurant Revitalization program to allow distilleries that are prohibited by State law from meeting the onsite sales requirements under the program to participate in the program.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RESTAURANT REVITALIZATION.**

4 The Administrator of the Small Business Administra-
5 tion shall amend the rules relating to the Restaurant Revi-
6 talization program under section 5003 of the American

1 Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (Public Law 117–2; 135 Stat.
2 85; 15 U.S.C. 9009c) to allow a distillery that is located
3 in a State the law of which sets a limit on the percentage
4 of the gross receipts of a distillery that may come from
5 onsite sales that is less than 33 percent to qualify as an
6 eligible entity under such section if the combined total of
7 the gross receipts of the distillery from onsite sales and
8 sales to retailers for onsite sale is not less than 33 percent.

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
