A BILL

To amend the Champlain Valley National Heritage Partnership Act of 2006 to reauthorize the Champlain Valley National Heritage Partnership, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Champlain Valley Na-
5 tional Heritage Partnership Reauthorization Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF CHAMPLAIN VALLEY NA-**
7 **TIONAL HERITAGE PARTNERSHIP.**

8 (a) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
9 288(a) of the Champlain Valley National Heritage Part-

1 nership Act of 2006 (54 U.S.C. 320101 note; Public Law
 2 109–338; 120 Stat. 1824) is amended by striking “not
 3 more than a total” and all that follows through “any fiscal
 4 year” and inserting “\$1,000,000 for each of fiscal years
 5 2022 through 2036”.

6 (b) NON-FEDERAL SHARE.—Section 288(b) of the
 7 Champlain Valley National Heritage Partnership Act of
 8 2006 (54 U.S.C. 320101 note; Public Law 109–338; 120
 9 Stat. 1824) is amended by striking “50 percent” and in-
 10 serting “25 percent”.

11 (c) TERMINATION OF AUTHORITY.—Section 289 of
 12 the Champlain Valley National Heritage Partnership Act
 13 of 2006 (54 U.S.C. 320101 note; Public Law 109–338;
 14 120 Stat. 1824) is amended by striking “on the date that
 15 is 15 years after the date of enactment of this Act” and
 16 inserting “on September 30, 2036”.

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
