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## A BILL

To amend the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021 to increase the fiscal year 2021 commitments to guarantee certain business loans of the Small Business Administration.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Continuing Access to  
5 504 Capital Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. SBA BUSINESS LOANS.**

7 Title V of division E of the Consolidated Appropria-  
8 tions Act, 2021 (Public Law 116–260) is amended, under

1 the heading “(INCLUDING TRANSFER OF FUNDS)” under  
2 the heading “BUSINESS LOANS PROGRAM ACCOUNT” under  
3 the heading “SMALL BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION”, in the  
4 second proviso, by striking “\$7,500,000,000” and insert-  
5 ing “\$8,500,000,000”.

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
