A BILL

To require the Secretary of Health and Human Services to publicly disclose information regarding adverse effects of COVID–19 vaccines.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Transparency in
5 COVID–19 Vaccination Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PUBLIC DISCLOSURE REGARDING COVID–19 VAC-**
7 **CINES.**

8 The Secretary of Health and Human Services shall
9 disclose to the public—

- 1 (1) all adverse events that have arisen from ad-
2 ministration of COVID–19 vaccines;
- 3 (2) an outline of the statistical occurrence and
4 likelihood of adverse events from administration of
5 such vaccines; and
- 6 (3) information concerning adverse effects of
7 such vaccines taken from findings of clinical trials or
8 other studies.

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
