A BILL

To prohibit the imposition of a fine, fee, or taxation on any person for violation of a COVID–19 vaccine mandate issued by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration or any other executive agency, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Taxation Without
5 Congressional Consent Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON OSHA AND OTHER EXECUTIVE**
2 **AGENCIES IMPOSING FINES, FEES, OR TAXES**
3 **WITH RESPECT TO COVID-19 VACCINE MAN-**
4 **DATES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—No fine, fee, or taxation shall be
6 imposed on any person for violating a COVID-19 vaccine
7 mandate issued by the Occupational Safety and Health
8 Administration or any other executive agency.

9 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

10 (1) COVID-19 VACCINE MANDATE.—The term
11 “COVID-19 vaccine mandate” means any require-
12 ment that an individual receive a COVID-19 vac-
13 cine, including any requirement that an employer re-
14 quire an employee or independent contractor to re-
15 ceive such a vaccine.

16 (2) EXECUTIVE AGENCY.—The term “executive
17 agency” has the meaning given such term in section
18 105 of title 5, United States Code.

19 (3) PERSON.—The term “person” has the
20 meaning given such term in section 2510 of title 18,
21 United States Code.

22 (c) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this sec-
23 tion shall be construed to allow for or otherwise authorize
24 a COVID-19 vaccine mandate issued by an Act of Con-
25 gress or by an executive agency.
