A BILL

To require an audit of COVID–19 relief funding.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Transparency in
5 COVID–19 Expenditures Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. COVID–19 RELIEF FUNDING AUDIT.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Comptroller General of the
8 United States shall conduct an audit of the use of all fund-
9 ing provided by the legislation described in subsection (b)
10 and submit a report on the findings of such audit to Con-
11 gress.

1 (b) LEGISLATION.—The legislation described in this
2 subsection includes the following:

3 (1) The Coronavirus Preparedness and Re-
4 sponse Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2020
5 (Public Law 116–123).

6 (2) The Families First Coronavirus Response
7 Act (Public Law 116–127).

8 (3) The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic
9 Security Act (Public Law 116–136).

10 (4) The Paycheck Protection Program and
11 Health Care Enhancement Act (Public Law 116–
12 139).

13 (5) Divisions M and N of the Consolidated Ap-
14 propriations Act, 2021 (Public Law 116–260).

15 (6) The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021
16 (Public Law 117–2).

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
