A BILL

To allow participants in the National Health Service Corps to defer their obligated service in order to receive training in palliative care services.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Provider Training in
5 Palliative Care Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DEFERRAL OF OBLIGATED SERVICES FOR TRAIN-**
7 **ING IN PALLIATIVE CARE.**

8 Section 331 of the Public Health Service Act (42
9 U.S.C. 254d) is amended—

1 (1) by redesignating subsection (j) as sub-
2 section (k); and

3 (2) by inserting after subsection (i) the fol-
4 lowing:

5 “(j) In carrying out subpart III, the Secretary may
6 issue deferrals of the period of obligated service to individ-
7 uals who have entered into a contract for obligated service
8 under the Scholarship Program or the Loan Repayment
9 Program and who apply for such a deferral in order to
10 receive training in palliative care. The Secretary may
11 grant such a deferral to such an individual for a period
12 of up to 1 year.”.

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
