A BILL

To amend the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 to extend the discretionary spending limits.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DISCRETIONARY SPENDING**
4 **LIMITS.**

5 Section 251(c) of the Balanced Budget and Emer-
6 gency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (2 U.S.C. 901(c)) is
7 amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (7)(B), by striking “and” at
2 the end; and

3 (2) by inserting after paragraph (8) the fol-
4 lowing:

5 “(9) for fiscal year 2022—

6 “(A) for the revised security category,
7 \$684,930,000,000 in new budget authority; and

8 “(B) for the revised nonsecurity category,
9 \$639,030,000,000 in new budget authority;

10 “(10) for fiscal year 2023—

11 “(A) for the revised security category,
12 \$698,628,600,000 in new budget authority; and

13 “(B) for the revised nonsecurity category,
14 \$651,810,600,000 in new budget authority; and

15 “(11) for fiscal year 2024, and each fiscal year
16 thereafter—

17 “(A) for the revised security category, the
18 baseline amount of new budget authority esti-
19 mated for the revised security category for such
20 fiscal year by the Office of Management and
21 Budget in accordance with section 257; and

22 “(B) for the revised nonsecurity category,
23 the baseline amount of new budget authority es-
24 timated for the revised nonsecurity category for

- 1 such fiscal year by the Office of Management
- 2 and Budget in accordance with section 257;”.

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
